

## Derby Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnership Action Plan Antisocial Behaviour

**Strategic aim - To balance the rights of individuals and communities to a life free from fear, harassment, alarm and distress.**

**Objective 1 – Develop and analyse high quality data on antisocial behaviour focusing on**

- areas where antisocial behaviour is concentrated
- families and individuals causing persistent problems
- alcohol related disorder
- criminal damage, arson and abandoned and burnt out vehicles
- harassment
- fear of antisocial behaviour/impact on quality of life
- young people as victims and perpetrator
